Our film will document an initiative to provide support for the young pastors in a challenging field that is 90% Muslim and almost 10% Hindu.

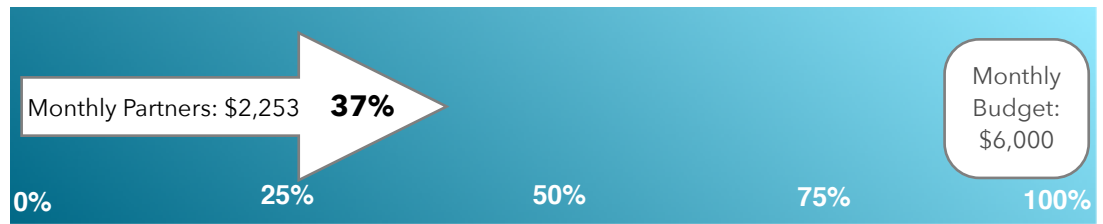
### Mexico (Apr. 2015)

## Special Needs For Upcoming Projects

As we look toward our 2015 filming schedule, there are several pieces of gear that will help us do this with excellence. As God leads, perhaps you can give a one time gift toward their purchase. (Idaho Use Tax is included in the costs.)

These items are listed in order of importance for our next trips.



### 1) ThinkTank Camera Backpack x 2 = \$423.27

To carry and protect our expensive gear on smaller regional jets and to pack into the Costa Rican jungle and through the congested streets of Bangladesh.



### 2) First Need XLE Water Purifier = \$133.10

Won't help with poisonous spiders, frogs or snakes, but should make the water safer.



### 3) XUME Lens Adapters, Filter Holders & Push On Lens Covers = \$165.31

Adding, removing and changing lens filters in dirty/wet/crowded settings is difficult and potentially destructive of gear. These magnetic adapter/holders will make it (literally) a snap.



### 4) Panasonic GH4 Camera Body, SD Memory Cards & Extra Batteries = \$2245.07

This one camera will allow us to do shots that would ordinarily require two cameras. The quality of images from this revolutionary camera and the slow-motion capabilities are extraordinary. A powerful tool at a great price.



### 5) Switronix TorchLED Bolt 220W On-Camera Light & Airbox Macro Softbox Kit with Eggcrate = \$359.22

A versatile battery-powered light that can be used on camera or mounted on a stand. Includes a rechargeable battery and swivel-mount. Great for interviews!
