work. So, just like the missionaries we serve, we will rely upon partners who believe in how important it is to tell these stories that 1) connect missionaries with a larger group of prayer and financial partners, 2) serve as a tool that's able to stir people's hearts toward missions and 3) that glorifies God by telling of His wonderful work around the world.


